### I. CALL TO ORDER

- Many businesses have already reached their charitable limits for the year. Dawn suggests that we hold off until January so we can get more businesses to participate. The cards will be good for the 2018 year.
- Another fundraising suggestion is a dinner concert and have the jazz bands perform. Venezia may do this as well as a few wineries. All liked the idea and Dawn will pursue

- Brayden mentioned his experience walking door to door in uniform selling bomberopoly games playing music getting a lot of attention and success
