Meeting Minutes

Opening

Approval of Minutes

- The minutes were reviewed, Jackie Martin made a motion to approve the minutes with a correction to the spelling of Jackie Martin and the removal of a Co-Secretary, changing Raye Lynn Brown as Secretary. Robin DeLorenzo seconded the motion, none were opposed.

Treasurers Report – Robin DeLorenzo

- The treasurers report was distributed.
- In lieu of being able to recover the existing PayPal account, she created a new one for the Music Booster to use.
- It has been determined that money left in the ASB fund from past contributors was available for the director to use as needed, but was not available for a direct payout.
- Treasurer Briefcase annual upgrade was purchased for unlimited transactions.

Director's Report – Jason Rose

- The orchestra showcase would be split up into two sessions with the first session being high school and 8th grade, and the second session being elementary, 6th and 7th grades. The first session would be during the week before spring break, with the second session being on the previously scheduled showcase date.
- New York City Trip
 - Registration and payment do not go through the school, but through Educational Discovery Tours.
 - ASB funds can be utilized for this trip.
 - Two chaperones have already been identified for the trip. The ideal ratio being one adult for every eight students. Chaperone forms will be available later when the number of participants has been determined.
- Marching Band show for 2016 theme will be “Firebird” (Igor Stravinsky)

President's Report – Jackie Marin

- Drums Along the Columbia will be held at Edgar Brown Memorial Stadium July 5, 2016. Doors open at Noon. Prices to be announced later and volunteers are needed.
- Students will be selling business card advertisements and pre-sale tickets.
- Anne See reports that the boys' and girls' basketball teams are doing well with a high probability of going to the state tournaments. If that happens with either or both, the Pep Band would be travelling with the teams and help would be needed for refreshments.

Old Business

- Fan Club T-shirt order forms and money are due tomorrow, February 3.

New Business

- Ginger Wireman has been coordinating the Butter Braids sales. Start date will be February 19 with student orders due March 8, orders due to the distributor March 11. Delivery will be March 22. Information and pricing will be coming.

New Business (Continued)

- A new fund raiser idea to have a “Band Camp” for younger band students to include Marching Band, Pep Band, and Color Guard was discussed. This could include T-shirts and half-time performances. Further development of this idea is warranted.
- Spring Fling is scheduled for May 20. Volunteers are needed, silent auction baskets are needed, with more attention paid to them this year.

Open Discussion

- Rebecca Hodges and Nici Hillebrant explained that they would no longer be altering uniforms. They are both willing to assist whomever is recruited to fill this position.
- More tuxedos, buttons, Shacos and gloves are needed.
- Dawson’s is willing to sell older stock rental quality tuxedos to the band. It was noted that we should not ever purchase polyester tuxedos again.
- Wooden and/or heavy duty plastic hangers and some carts are needed for uniforms.
- Clothing racks would be very useful for checking in uniforms and tuxedos. Robin DeLorenzo will search for and price portable clothing racks.
- In the spring we need to take Marching Band uniforms apart for dry cleaning in preparation for the next season. This needs to be completed and uniforms returned before the school year ends.
- Tuxedos need to be returned after the last concert of the year, May 24.
- Awards night will be May 31.
- We are at least one, more likely two seasons away from purchasing new Marching Band uniforms.
