Meeting Minutes

Opening

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Approval of Minutes

- May meeting minutes were reviewed. Motion to approve was made by Robin DeLorenzo, seconded by Tony DeLorenzo. None were opposed.

Treasurers Report – Robin DeLorenzo

- Treasurers report was distributed. Projected expenditures for leadership camp will deplete our funds mostly if not completely.

President's Report – Jackie Marin

- Agreement and expectation forms for leadership academy were distributed to section leaders to be filled out by students and family.
- Students need to look up information online for leadership camp and register for their chosen camp online before the deadline. If students need assistance registering, Jackie Martin would be available to assist.
- Drum camp for Nathan Higley would be paid for by leftover student ASB funds from outgoing seniors. Other section leaders' camps would be paid at 50%.

Old Business

- Drum Along the Columbia will be July 5, 2016. Volunteers are needed, sign-up can be done online.
- Welcome letter is waiting only on football and competition schedules. Everett competition is not planned, Spokane is uncertain.
- Hogs and Dogs volunteers are needed June 16, 2016 at 8:45 PM. Volunteers should bring pocket knives and wear closed-toe shoes. We will take down tents and pick up garbage. Expected time to completion is 2 hours. Pizza may be provided. This event should earn \$500 for the RHSIMB.

New Business

- Phone book deliveries will be July 2 through 16. We receive 25 cents per book delivered.
- Marching Band Camp will be August 15 to 19, 2016 from 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM and August 22 to 26 from 3:00 PM to 9:00 PM. Students are encouraged to bring sunscreen and lots of water. Light snacks such as fruit and popsicles should be available. Dairy products are discouraged.
- Marching Band parent meeting will be held on August 23, 2016, time to be announced.
- Bowling Party should occur on August 24, time is usually 1:00 PM.
- Family Barbecue will be August 26, time to be announced.

Open Discussion

- Dozens of questions were fielded from leadership on a wide variety of topics including uniforms and rosters. The majority of these questions need to be answered directly by Mr. Rose. The students were informed of this and asked to allow a few weeks for vacation time before contacting Mr. Rose with their questions.

Open Discussion (Continued)

- Marching Band planning meeting date and time are to be announced. Leadership is invited and encouraged to attend. We will be checking inventory for marching band supplies.
- Leadership was invited to attend all RHSIMB meetings, currently held on the second Tuesday of each month at 6:30 PM.
- Band camp is expected to utilize the baseball field this year. City as well as school needs contacted about turning off the sprinklers. If it is windy, the tents need to be taken down.
- Uniforms must be fit no later than the second week of band camp.
- Forms (anti-hazing, anti-bullying, volunteer, contact information, and membership) need to be filled out and returned by participants.
- Tony DeLorenzo priced tuxedo racks at \$50 each. Two are needed. Edna Felix offered to purchase one clothing stand. Tony was approved to order both racks.
- Mark Brown and Mr. Edwards have been in contact with each other. A meeting time was still forthcoming. A commercial kitchen may available to rent from Northwest Regional Food Hub for \$10 per hour for food preparation if necessary.
- Ginger Wireman asked the leadership to consider how they felt about a contract for marching band members with the idea of having it signed by Spring Break. Further discussion to be held at a later date.
- A published wish-list was discussed. Band members, leadership, and RHSIMB members should provide an itemized, prioritized list of items that we want or need. If a person were willing to make a donation, they could choose to provide the monetary value of the item, or purchase the item itself.
- We need to hold more fund raisers. We need more participation from all instrumental music students. Leadership should be responsible for encouraging their sections to participate in fund-raising events.
- Bomber Boosters may be able to help with some funding.
